In STEM we will explore the Boston Museum of Science (BMS) Engineering Unit- Rockets and Rovers. In each of the units two characters India and Jacob introduce the design challenges. Meanwhile, India is learning about the trade-offs and variables involved in engineering a rocket as she blasts off to the International Space Station.
