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## What is 21 Club/LearningWorks Afterschool?

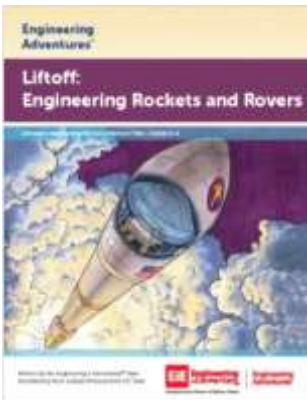
21 Club is a hands-on, project-based afterschool program focused on STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, and Math) education. 21 Club is specifically designed to give students a positive learning experience that fosters **excitement about learning** and contributes to their **confidence** and **success** in school!

21 Club provides opportunities every day to practice and reinforce skills in **reading** (fiction and nonfiction), **writing** (science notebooks), **math**, **speaking/listening**, and **vocabulary**.

Students participate in “Engineering Adventures” from the Boston Museum of Science, where they build skills in: Problem solving, Teamwork, Communication, Creative Thinking.

## Curriculum Highlight – Winter Engineering Unit

Students and staff are busy with our winter Engineering Adventures's unit: **Lift Off! Engineering Rockets and Rovers.**



Students have been busy engineering rockets and rovers to help explore several planets and moons in our solar system. Staff has been very busy building on the unit with lessons on the planets, building models, and teaching students about what life is like on the International Space Station.
