




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Dear LearningWorks Families,

This summer students will participate in an engineering unit called *Civil Engineering: Designing Bridges*, which is part of the *Engineering is Elementary* curriculum developed by the Boston Museum of Science. Throughout this unit, students will use what they learn about the science of balance and forces to design and improve a bridge. The unit will begin with a story about a boy from Texas who solves a similar engineering design challenge.

There are many reasons to introduce children to engineering in elementary school:

*Children are fascinated with building and taking things apart to see how they work. Engineering encourages these exploration.

*Engineering fosters problem solving skills

*Learning about engineering will increase students' awareness of and access to scientific and technical careers.
